“The Way of What is to Come”: Reading *Liber Primus*

Dr. Sonu Shamdasani introduces us to reading *Liber Primus* - the first parchment signature of Jung's ***Red Book***. Dr. Shamdasani will reconstruct the sequence of events that underlay it, the various levels of elaboration and commentary, and Jung's subsequent attempt to translate its conceptions into his scholarly writings.
