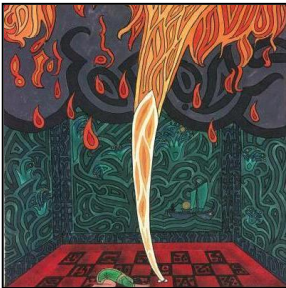

# JUNG & THE SPIRITUAL JOURNEY: A YEAR WITH THE *RED BOOK* with Stephen Martz, D.Min.

**Sundays, 4:30 – 6:30 p.m, October 2011 – June 2012**



For years, those interested in Jung's reflection on his own inner journey had to rely primarily on *Memories, Dreams, Reflections* – a text composed late in Jung's life and considered to be only partially written by Jung. *The Red Book*, published late in 2009, now affords students of Jung direct access to profound, though dense diary-like inner material Jung recorded during his "confrontation with the unconscious" in the years immediately following his 1913 break with Freud. In this guided reading group, we will move carefully and deliberately through *The Red Book*, seeking to understand its meaning and to ask how Jung's inner work might illuminate our own journeys.
