



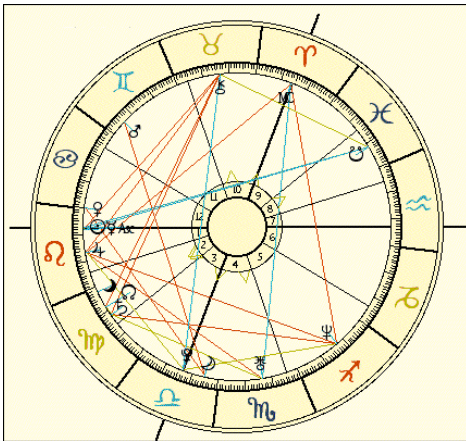

CYCLE OF SATURN: DEATH AND RENEWAL OF THE KING

This seminar in Psychological Astrology will trace the planetary cycle of Saturn, the planet in alchemical tradition associated with the “Old King,” whose death and transformation brought about the renewal of the kingdom. From the time of our birth, each of us follows a goal known only to ourselves toward our “kingdom on earth,” and only we know when it is achieved. Jung recognized that the achievement of this goal required engagement with the Shadow, the dark, unknown and fearful place within. A psychological look at the planetary cycle of Saturn tells the story of engagement with our Shadow and our search for manifestation of our life goals. This goal may be relationship, service to others or the creation of a nurturing environment: for others, it may be public recognition through the arts or politics, finances or publication.

Dr. Robert will provide an explanation of the timing, mythology, symbolism and psychological meaning of the planetary cycle of Saturn, and how to apply this cycle to their chart. No prior knowledge of astrology is necessary. Participants will have the option to provide their birth data in advance, so they may apply the timing of the Saturn Cycle to their chart during the class and share material about the timing and experience of the Saturn Cycle. Alternatively, the participants may request a copy of their chart and the timing, but choose to keep their chart confidential during the class.
